



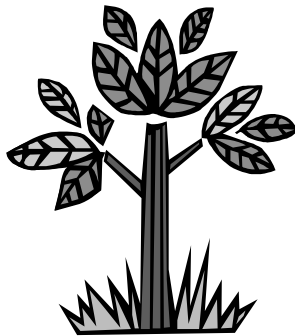

## Adopt-a-Park

The Santa Teresa Foothills Neighborhood Association has adopted two parks in the Santa Teresa Foothills, Century Oaks Park and Foothill Park. The purpose of this program is to help create and preserve clean and safe parks for everyone. You can help by participating in periodic cleanup events. Work so far has included installation of native plants and trees as well as an irrigation system, trashcan and bench at the section of Century Oaks Park at Snell and Colleen Ave.

This work was done in cooperation with the San Jose Park's Department's Adopt-A-Park program as well as with assistance from Our City Forest.

## Coyote-Alamitos Trail Update

The City of San Jose has retained the firm of Amphion Environmental for the purpose of preparing a feasibility study for the Coyote-Alamitos Trail.

The feasibility study, which was initiated in May 2002, will consist of a preliminary assessment of the numerous environmental, legal, and financial issues associated with such a facility. Public input will be an important part of the study and community meetings will be scheduled for that purpose. Staff from the City's Parks, Recreation & Neighborhood Services Department will provide information regarding the scope of the feasibility at our upcoming May 29<sup>th</sup> Association meeting.

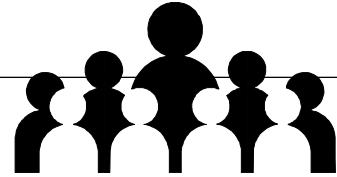
